#### Class # Class Description

#### A CATTLEYA ALLIANCE

- 101 Cattleya and Laelia species.
- 102 Cattleya Alliance species other than above. (e.g. Barkeria, Brassovola, Epidendrum, Sophronitis)
- 103 Cattleya Alliance hybrids which closely resemble their parent species. (Excluding standard, mini and compact Cattleyas.)
- 104 Best grown plant from classes 101-103 (Rosette)
- 105 Best flower from classes 101-103 (Rosette)
- 111 Coerulea (Standard Sized Cattleyas). (Flowers greater than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 112 Lavender, purple and pink (Standard Sized Cattleyas). (Flowers greater than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 113 White, white with colored lip (Standard Sized Cattleyas). (Flowers greater than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 114 Yellow, green and yellow with colored lip (Standard Sized Cattleyas). (Flowers greater than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 115 Red, orange, bronze, art shades (Standard Sized Cattleyas). (Flowers greater than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 116 Splash-petal, spots, patterns (Standard Sized Cattleyas). (Flowers greater than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 117 Coerulea, lavender, purple and pink (Mini and Compact Cattleyas). (Flowers less than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 118 White, white with colored lip (Mini and Compact Cattleyas). (Flowers less than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 119 Yellow, green and yellow with colored lip (Mini and Compact Cattleyas). (Flowers less than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 120 Red, orange, bronze and art shades (Mini and Compact Cattleyas). (Flowers less than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 121 Splash-petal, spots, patterns (Mini and Compact Cattleyas) (Flowers less than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)
- 122 Best grown plant from classes 111-121 (Rosette)
- 123 Best flower from classes 111-116 (Rosette)
- 125 Best flower from classes 117-121 (Rosette) (Flowers less than 4 inches or 10 cm in diameter.)

#### B CYPRIPEDIUM ALLIANCE

- 201 Cypripedium species and hybrids.
- 203 Paphiopedilum species from sections Parvisepalum and Brachypetalum (armeniicum, micranthum, malipoense, emersonii, bellatulum, delenatii, niveum, godefroyae).
- 204 Paphiopedilum hybrids and intersectional hybrids from sections Parvisepalum and Brachypetalum).
- 205 Paphiopedilum multifloral species and hybrids. (At least 3 flowers open on 1 inflorescence.)
- 206 Paphiopedilum sequentially-blooming species and hybrids.
- 207 Paphiopedilum species - all others.
- 208 Paphiopedilum novelty hybrids (vinicolor and coloratum).
- 209 Paphiopedilum novelty hybrids - all other colors.
- 210 Paphiopedilum complex hybrids - (rounded flowers) - all colors.
- 211 Phragmipedium species.
- 212 Phragmipedium hybrids predominantly red (besseae and fischeri).
- 213 Phragmipedium hybrids other colors and backgrounds.
- 215 Best grown plant from classes 201-212 (Rosette)
- 216 Best flower from classes 201-212 (Rosette) – Lee Richard Memorial Trophy

#### C VANDA AND PHALAENOPSIS ALLIANCE, VANDACEOUS/AERANGIS/ANGRAECIDS

- 301 Angraecoid species.
- 302 Angraecoid hybrids and intergeneric hybrids excluding Ascocenda.
- 303 Ascocenda hybrids - all colors.
- 304 Neofinetia falcata species, intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 305 Vanda species.
- 306 Vanda hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.

#### Class # Class Description

- 307 Allied genera species.
- 308 Allied genera hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above - excluding Doritis, Phalaenopsis and Paraphalaenopsis.
- 309 Best grown plant from classes 301-308 (Rosette) – Don & Jane Grisham Memorial Trophy
- 310 Best flower from classes 301-308 (Rosette)
- 319 Doritis, Phalaenopsis and Paraphalaenopsis species - all colors.
- 320 Solid white (may have yellow on lip) - Miniatures - flowers less than 6 cm. (excluding venosa, violacea and amboinensis types).
- 321 Solid pink - Miniatures - flowers less than 6 cm. (excluding venosa, violacea and amboinensis hybrids).
- 322 White with any colored markings - Mini and compact miniatures - flowers less than 6 cm. (excluding venosa, violacea and amboinensis).
- 324 Base color yellow with any markings or overlay color - Novelty hybrids.
- 325 Base color red with any markings or overlay color - Novelty hybrids.
- 326 Solid reds or purples - Novelty hybrids.
- 327 Base color white with any markings or overlay color - Novelty hybrids.
- 328 Solid white (may have yellow on lip) - Standard Phalaenopsis hybrids - flowers larger than 6 cm.
- 331 White with any other color markings - Standard Phalaenopsis hybrids - flowers larger than 6 cm.
- 332 Pink solid color (may have white lip) - Standard Phalaenopsis hybrids - flowers larger than 6 cm.
- 333 Harlequins - all colors.
- 334 Best grown plant from classes 319-333 (Rosette)
- 335 Best flower from classes 319-333 (Rosette)

### D ONCIDIUM ALLIANCE

- 401 Brassia species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids.
- 402 Odontoglossum species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 403 Miltonia and Miltoniopsis species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 404 Compariettia alliance species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 405 Tolumnia species and hybrids - all colors. (see Genus/Class key)
- 406 Oncidium species.
- 407 Oncidium Alliance species other than above.
- 408 Oncidium Alliance hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above. (see Genus/Class key)
- 409 Best grown plant from classes 401- 407 (Rosette)
- 410 Best flower from classes 401- 407 (Rosette)

### E DENDROBIUM ALLIANCE

- 501 Miniatures - plants less than 4" tall - species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids.
- 502 Flowers resembling Phalaenopsis. (Phalaenanthe Section) species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids.
- 503 Antelope type flowers - all colors. (Spatulata Section) species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids.
- 504 Callista and Formosae (Nigrohirsuta Sections) species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids.
- 505 Nobile-type (Eugenanthe Section) species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids.
- 506 All sections and allied genera not listed above - species and hybrids.
- 507 Best grown plant from classes 501-506 (Rosette)
- 508 Best flower from classes 501-506 (Rosette)

### F MISCELLANEOUS GENERA

- 601 Miniatures - plants less than 3" tall - species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids.
- 602 Cymbidium and allied genera species and hybrids.
- 603 Catasetum, Cynoches, Gongora, Mormodes, Stanhopea and allied genera species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids.
- 604 Lycaste and Anguloa species and hybrids.
- 605 Zygopetalum species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 606 Maxillareae species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 607 Bulbophyllum and Cirrhopetalum species and hybrids.
- 608 Masdevallia and Dracula species.

- 609 Masdevallia and Dracula hybrids.
- 610 Pleurothallis, Stelis and Allied Genera: species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids.

- 612 All genera grown for beauty of foliage (need not be in bloom).
- 613 Best grown plant from classes 601-612 (Rosette)
- 614 Best flower from classes 601-612 (Rosette)

### **G ORCHIDS IN USE - Orchids must be used in all of the following classes, but do not have to be grown by the exhibitor. Other non-floral material may be used. No artificial flowers or foliage may be used. Accessories are permitted.**

- 701 Interpretive arrangement - showing originality.
- 702 Miniature arrangement - total height not to exceed 6 inches.
- 703 Corsage
- 704 Best use of orchids from classes 701-703 (Rosette)

### **H Exhibits - Trophy Classes - (Non-commercial) Any exhibit entered in non-commercial classes shall be comprised solely of plants grown by the exhibitor(s).**

- 801 Best novice exhibit. First time Exhibitor – Dorothy R. Kaye Memorial Trophy.
- 802 Best exhibit with flowers grown under lights or on windowsills.
- 803 Best exhibit, flowers grown in a sunroom or under HID lights.
- 804 Hobbyist, Small Greenhouse (150 square feet or less).
- 805 Hobbyist, Medium Greenhouse (151 to 400 square feet).
- 806 Hobbyist, Large Greenhouse (greater than 400 square feet).
- 807 Best group exhibit. (Two or more exhibitors.)
- 808 Best Society exhibit.
- 809 Best commercial exhibit.
- 810 Best educational exhibit.
- 811 Best orchid collectible exhibit.
- 812 Best orchid art created by the exhibitor (includes photography).
- 813 Best exhibit using 5 or fewer plants or cut inflorescence.
- 814 Best exhibit by a Not-For-Profit Publicly Supported Institution.
- 815 Best Display Exhibit
- 816 Best Exhibit - Show Theme - "Orchid Oasis" - Please look at all exhibits.
