Class

A. CATTLEYA ALLIANCE

- 101 Cattleya and Laelia species
- 102 Cattleya Alliance species other than above
- 103 Cattleya Alliance hybrids (other than standard, mini and compact hybrids)
- 104 Best grown plant from classes 101-103
- 105 Best Flower from classes 101-103

Standard Cattleya - plants 12 inches or taller

- 106 Lavender, Purple, Coerulea and Pink
- 107 White, white with colored lip
- 108 Yellow, green, yellow with colored lip, red, orange, bronze and art shades
- 109 Splash-petal, spots, patterns

Mini and Compact Cattleyas - plants less than 12 inches

- 110 Coerulea, lavender, purple and pink
- 111 White, white with colored lip
- 112 Yellow, green, yellow with colored lip, red, orange, bronze and art shades
- 113 Splash-petal, spots, patterns
- 114 Best grown plant from classes 106-113
- 115 Best flower from classes 106-113

B. CYPRIPEDIUM ALLIANCE

- 201 Cypripedium and Phragmipedium species
- 202 Cypripedium and Phragmipedium hybrids
- 203 Paphiopedilum species (**excluding** Brachypetalum and Parvisepalum, and multifloral and sequentially blooming species)
- 204 Paphiopedilum - Parvisepalum and brachypetalum species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids closely resembling their parent species.
- 205 Novelty hybrids (closely resembling the species) - Vinicolor and coloratum (**excluding** multifloral hybrids)
- 206 Novelty hybrids - all other colors (**excluding** multifloral hybrids)
- 207 Complex hybrids (rounded flowers) - all colors
- 208 Multifloral species and hybrids - all colors
- 209 Paphiopedilum - Sequential bloomers
- 213 Best grown plant from classes 201-209
- 214 Best flower from classes 201-209

C. VANDA AND PHALAENOPSIS ALLIANCE, VANDACEOUS/AERANGIS/ANGRAECOIDS

- 301 Angraecoids, species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids **excluding** Ascocenda
- 302 Ascocenda Hybrids - all colors
- 303 Vanda species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above
- 304 Allied Genera species - hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above - excluding Doritis, Phalaenopsis and Paraphalaenopsis
- 305 Doritis, Paraphalaenopsis and Phalaenopsis species - all colors

Miniatures - flowers less than 2 1/2 inches Excluding lueddemanniana, venosa, violacea and amboinensis hybrids)

- 306 Solid white (may have yellow on lip)
- 307 Solid pink
- 308 White with colored lip
- 309 All other colors with any markings

lueddemanniana, venosa, violacea and amboinensis hybrids

- 310 Base color Yellow with any markings or overlay color - Novelty hybrids (lueddemanniana, venosa, violacea, amboinensis types)
- 311 Base color red with any markings or overlay color - novelty hybrids, etc.
- 312 Solid reds or purples - Novelty hybrids (lueddemanniana, venosa, violacea, amboinensis types)
- 313 Base color White with any markings or overlay color - Novelty hybrids (lueddemanniana, venosa, violacea, amboinensis types)

Standard Phalaenopsis hybrids - flowers larger than 2 1/2 inches

- 314 Solid white (may have yellow on lip)
- 315 White with colored lip
- 316 White with pink - blushed, spotted, striped
- 317 White with any other color markings
- 318 Pink solid color - may have white lip
- 319 Pink with any markings
- 320 Yellow solid color
- 321 Yellow with any markings
- 322 Art shades
- 323 Best grown plant from classes 301-322
- 324 Best flower from classes 301-322

D. ONCIDIUM ALLIANCE

In classes 401 - 404 enter the class the flower most resembles

- 401 Brassia species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids resembling Brassia
- 402 Odontoglossum species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids resembling Odontoglossum
- 403 Miltonia and Miltoniopsis species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids resembling Miltonia
- 404 Comparettia Alliance species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids
- 405 Tolumnia species and hybrids - all colors (Equitant Oncidium)
- 406 Oncidium species from the varicosum, crispum and cyrtochilum sections
- 407 Oncidium, species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above
- 408 Best grown plant from classes 401-407
- 409 Best flower from classes 401-407

E. DENDROBIUM ALLIANCE

- 501 Miniatures - all species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids - plants less than 4 inches
- 502 Phalaenopsis-type - all colors. Flowers resembling Phalaenopsis (Phalaenanthe Section species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids)
- 503 Antelope Type Flowers - all colors (Ceratobium {Spatulatum} Section species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids).
- 504 Callista and nigrohirsute sections, species, hybrids and intersectional hybrids
- 505 Eugenanthe section (nobile-type) species and hybrids
- 506 All Sections and allied genera not listed above - species and hybrids
- 507 Best grown plant from classes 501-506
- 508 Best flower from classes 501-506

F. MISCELLANEOUS GENERA

- 601 Miniatures - all species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids - plants less than 4 inches
- 602 Cymbidium and allied genera species and hybrids
- 603 Catasetum, Cycnoches, Mormodes and allied genera species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids
- 604 Maxillarieae species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above.
- 605 Bulbophyllum and Cirrhopetalum species and hybrids
- 606 Masdevallia and Dracula species
- 607 Masdevallia and Dracula hybrids
- 608 Pleurothallis, Stelis and allied genera species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids other than above
- 609 All other genera not listed elsewhere, species, hybrids and intergeneric hybrids
- 610 All genera grown for beauty of foliage - need not be in bloom
- 611 Best grown plant from classes 601-610
- 612 Best flower from classes 601-610

G. ORCHIDS IN USE

Orchids must be used in all classes and do not have to have been grown by the exhibitor. Other non-floral material may be used. No artificial flowers or foliage may be used. Accessories are permitted.

- 701 Interpretive arrangement - showing originality
- 702 Miniature arrangement - total height not to exceed 6 inches
- 703 Corsage
- 704 Best arrangement of corsage

I. EXHIBITS - TROPHY CLASSES

(Non-Commercial) Any exhibit entered in non-commercial classes shall be comprised solely of plants grown by the exhibitor.

- 901 Best novice exhibit. First time exhibitor.
- 902 Best exhibit with flowers grown under lights or on windowsills.
- 903 Best exhibit, flowers grown in a sunroom.
- 904 Hobbyist, Small Greenhouse (150 square feet or less)
- 905 Hobbyist, Medium Greenhouse (151 to 400 square feet)
- 906 Hobbyist, Large Greenhouse (greater than 400 square feet)
- 907 Best group exhibit
- 908 Best Society exhibit
- 909 Best commercial exhibit
- 910 Best educational exhibit
- 911 Best orchid collectible exhibit
- 912 Best orchid art created by the exhibitor (includes photography)
- 913 Best exhibit using 5 or fewer plants or cut inflorescence
- 914 Best exhibit by a Not-For-Profit Publicly Supported Institution
- 915 Best Display Exhibit with plants owned less than 4 months
